

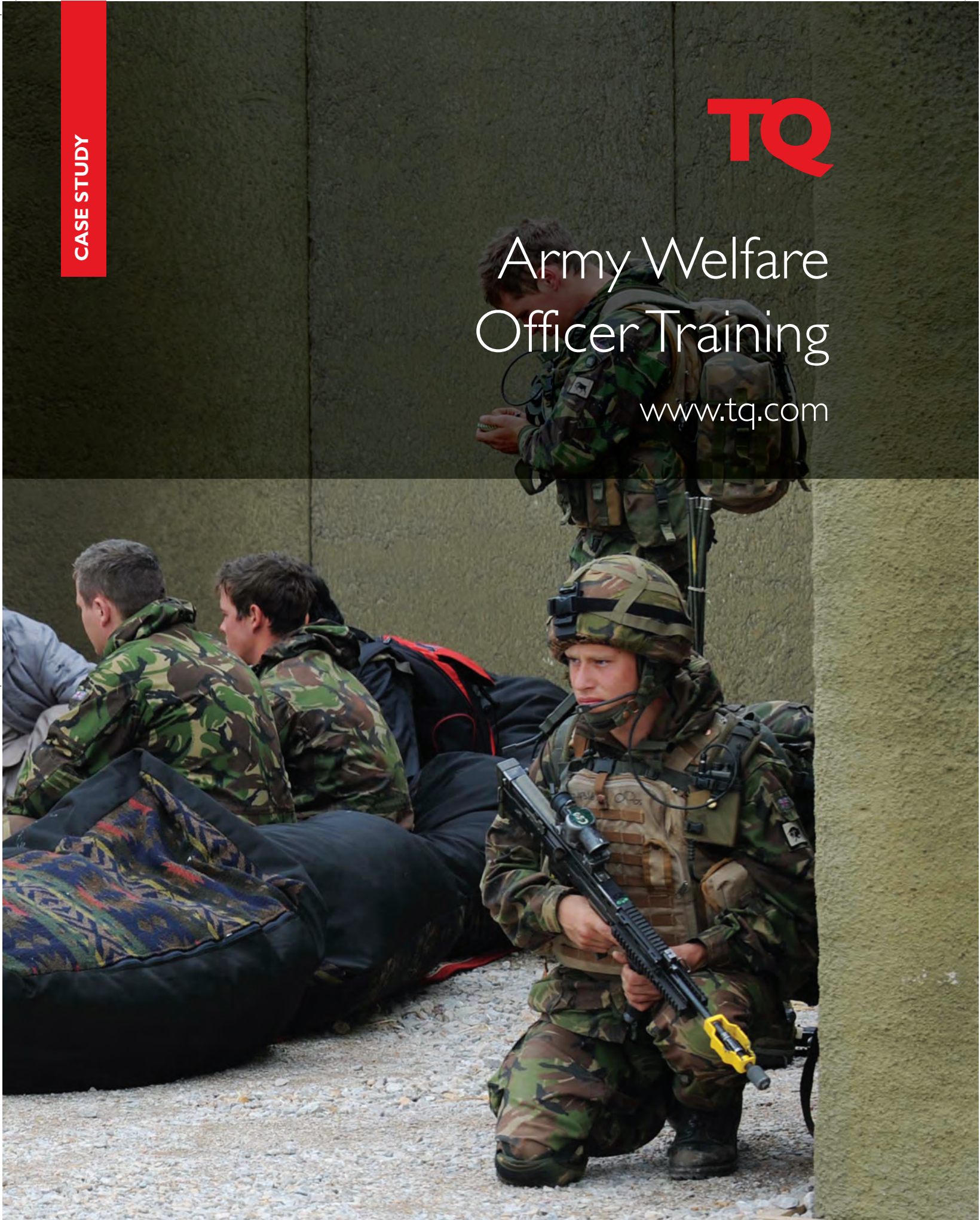

Army Welfare Officer Training

THE TRAINING REQUIREMENT

Support to soldiers and their families is a vital part of maintaining the morale of troops on the front line in order to ensure they are fit and able to undertake operations. The Army therefore has a requirement to provide core training for new Welfare Officers in order to give them an insight into the welfare issues they are likely to encounter.

THE TQ PROGRAMME

TQ delivers the two-part Welfare Officer courses at the Emergency Planning College in Yorkshire as well as training to Unit Welfare Office staff at various garrisons within the UK and overseas. The courses cover subjects such as child protection, domestic abuse, housing issues, bereavement and post traumatic stress disorder. Training includes development of listening and responding skills, and understanding the role of supporting agencies.
