

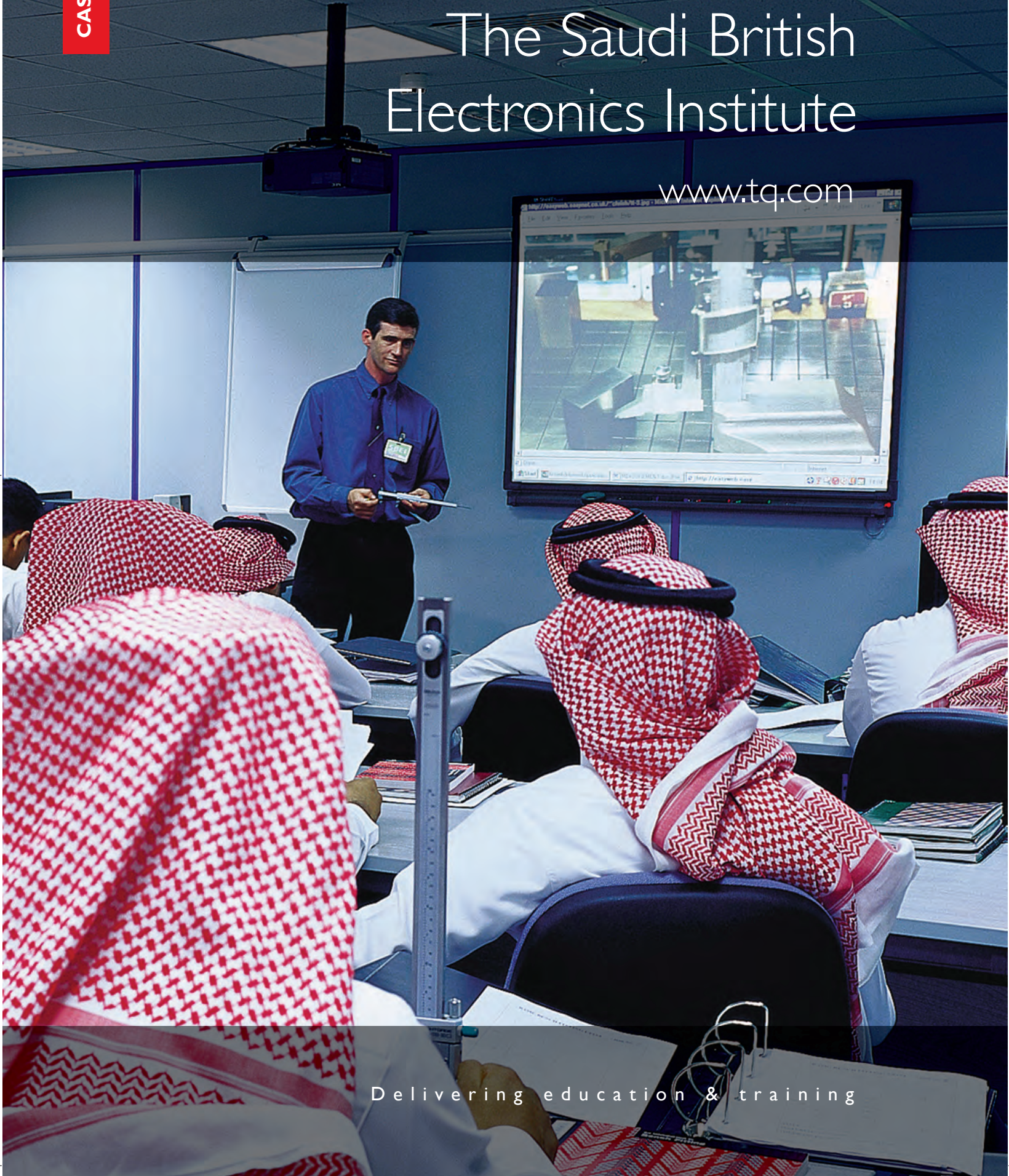

The Saudi British Electronics Institute

TQ secured a 5-year contract to establish and operate an electronics training institute in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.

THE TRAINING REQUIREMENT

The client was setting up an institute with the aims of meeting local employment needs within the specialist field of electronics; allowing progression into home country and overseas higher education systems; and meeting professional institute membership requirements in terms of educational background.

THE TQ PROGRAMME

With control over all aspects of the project, TQ was responsible for bespoke curriculum development; staff recruitment and training; provision of a management structure; development of IT, including an MIS; equipment and furniture; and contracting with service providers for facilities management and catering. The curriculum for the institute was completely tailor-made and accredited by the Scottish Qualifications Authority.
